

**BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN (BMA)
MINUTES FOR
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
September 5, 2023**

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Tullahoma, Coffee and Franklin Counties, Tennessee assembled at the Municipal Building, in Tullahoma, for a Special Called Meeting on Tuesday, September 5, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. with Mayor Ray Knowis presiding and the following named members of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen: Jenna Amacher, Daniel Berry, Kurt Glick, Derick Mann and Bobbie Wilson. Jerry Mathis was absent.

Mr. Kenney Pearson, Interim City Administrator; Mr. Stephen M. Worsham, City Attorney, and Mrs. Lori Ashley, City Recorder were present at the meeting.

Mayor Ray Knowis called the meeting to order.

Reading of the Call was done by City Recorder Lori Ashley.

The Invocation was said by Mayor Ray Knowis, and he led the Pledge of Allegiance.

As soon as HR provides employment documents and the candidate signs the documents, the candidate will start no later than October 1st. The candidate is subject to a ninety (90) day probationary period at which time the Board of Mayor and Alderman may choose to continue with or without a contract.

On roll call all members present voted aye on the amendment and it was so ordered.

On roll call all members present voted aye to present an employment offer to Mr. Jason Quick, City Administrator candidate and set an employment start date as amended, and it was so ordered.
